This is a closed meeting for a funded group of visiting scholars.

Although the field of participatory modeling (PM) has grown in recent years, there are still considerable questions about how different software tools common to PM can be used to facilitate communication and learning among diverse groups, which approaches are more or less suitable (given the nature of a community or environmental issue), and whether these approaches effectively lead to action-oriented outcomes. This project proposes to address these questions by convening a group of scientists, computational modelers, facilitators, and policy makers to systematically generate information about the process, the products, and the outcomes associated with different PM approaches.
